# 1. Simple Steps

# Conduct Puja with four simple steps:

- 1. Arrange Puja Samagri as per the provided list
- 2. Prepare Samagri as per Puja Layout
- 3. Overlook the Instructions Video
- 4. Log in and Play & Perform the Puja

# 2. Rudra Abhishek Total Puja samagri list

#### Non – Perisibale items

Shivling either of home or made of clay,1 piece of Kalash,4 diys, 1meter red cloth,30 grams of Chandan, a small packet of kumkum,100 grams of rice,5 suparis, one bottle of itar(scent),2 janau,moli, few coins,shringi (optional),2 piece rui batti, few agarbatti, matchbox,50 grams of ghee,30 grams of honey,30 grams of sugar, little bhang

#### **Perishable items**

50 grams of curd,2 to 3 litres of milk,4 litres of water, at least 10 bel patra, a few garlands,1/2 kg flowers, a bunch of tulsi, a few durvas, one coconut, a few fruits, a few sweets

Please note: Item A,B consists full puja samagri to conduct puja

# 3. Puja samagri & puja layout (Match the numbers)



#### (Table with numbers in Hindi & english & puja layout )

1. Those who keep a Shivling at home can place their Shiv ling. And those whose homes do not have a Shivling have the option to craft one from clay.

2. Kalash: Fill the kalash halfway with water, then add a coin, supari, durva, and mango leaf inside. Outside the Kalash, cover it with a saari or plate, fill it with rice, place a coconut wrapped in red cloth, and adorn it with flowers.

3. Take a small plate or saari, fill it with rice, and place 2 suparis wrapped with moli, and one janau on one supari. This is the preparation for Ganesh Ambika, with the Janue representing Lord Ganesh.4. Bell

5. One plate with various fruits and sweets for offering as Prasad.

6. Aarti thali with two diyas, one filled with ghee and cotton bati, while the other with camphor (Kapoor).keep extra kapoor in another diya7. For Shivji puja, arrange nine cups each containing:

i. Approx Mixture of milk, curd, and honey totaling 50 grams. (It is called madhupak)

ii. Approx 100 grams of milk.

iii. Approx 50 grams of curd.

iv. Approx 50 grams of sugar.

v. Approx 30 grams of ghee.

vi. Approx 30 grams of honey.

vii. Approx 30g Chandan and a little itar(scent) mixed in water viii. Approx Panchamrit: a mixture of milk, curd, sugar, honey, and ghee totalling 100 grams.

ix. Approx 50 grams of milk mixed with a little bhang and a little sugar.Use a small vessel (kalash) made of non-copper material or Shringi(Shringi is used during rudraabhishek, if you do not have shringi you can use a vessel (Kalash) made of non-copper

8. Prepare a ghee lamp using a small diya, cup, or saari, filled with ghee and a few agarbatti to light, a banana as a stand to keep agarbatti and a matchbox

9. Empty vessel to store water and milk poured on lord shiva

10. A plate consisting of Durva, approximately half a kilogram of flowers, a minimum of 10 Bel Patra, 2 to 3 garlands, and a bunch of tulsi

11. few pieces of supari, itar and 2 janau

12. Moli

- 13. few coins
- 14. Handful of rice
- 15. Kumkum
- 16. Chandan

17. Karam Patra - a small vessel filled with water for use during the puja.

- 18. little rice for participants use
- 19. little kumkum for participants use

20. Small towel

21. Pure clean water 4 liters to be used during rudra abhishek

22. Two to three litres of milk to be used during rudra abhishek

23. extra bigger size empty vessel to dispose of water/milk which would be poured on lord shiva

24. Aasan

## Note:

Keep a large empty vessel for draining milk and water, which will be offered to Lord Shiva.

Provide a small towel for hand cleaning during the puja.

1. जिनके पास घर में शिवलिंग है, वे अपने शिवलिंग का उपयोग कर सकते हैं, और जिनके पास नहीं है, वे मिट्टी से एक शिवलिंग बना सकते हैं।

\*\*कलश\*\*: कलश को आधा पानी से भरें, फिर उसमें एक सिक्का, सुपारी, दूर्वा, और आम का पत्ता डालें। कलश के बाहर एक सराई या प्लेट से ढकें, उसे चावल से भरें, एक नारियल को लाल कपड़े में लपेटें और उसे फूलों से सजाएं।
एक छोटी प्लेट या सराई लें, उसमें चावल भरें और उसमें मौली से लपेटी 2 सुपारी रखें। एक सुपारी पर एक जनेऊ रखें। यह गणेश अंबिका की तैयारी है, जिसमें जनेऊ भगवान गणेश का प्रतिनिधित्व करता है।

(श्रंगी का उपयोग रुद्राभिर्षक के दौरान किया जाता है, यदि आपके पास श्रंगी नहीं है तो आप गैर-तांबे की सामग्री से बने बर्तन का उपयोग कर सकते हैं)। 8. एक घी का दीपक तैयार करें जिसमें एक छोटा दीया, कप, या सराई हो, घी से भरा हुआ और कुछ अगरबत्ती जलाने के लिए, एक केला स्टैंड के रूप में अगरबत्ती रखने के लिए और माचिस। 9. पानी और दूध को भगवान शिव पर चढ़ाने के लिए एक खाली बर्तन। 10. एक प्लेट जिसमें थोड़े दूर्वा, लगभग आधा किलो फूल, कम से कम 10 बेल पत्र, 2 से 3 मालाएं, और तुलसी का एक गुच्छा हो।

एक छोटा बर्तन (कलश) गैर-तांबे की सामग्री से बना हुआ उपयोग करें या श्रंगी

- लगभग 50 ग्राम चीनी - लगभग 30 ग्राम घी - लगभग 30 ग्राम शहद

- लगभग 30 ग्राम चंदन और थोड़ा इत्र पानी में मिलाया हुआ

- लगभग 50 ग्राम दूध भांग और चीनी के साथ मिलाया हुआ

11. कुछ सुपारी के टुकड़े, इत्र और 2 जनेऊ।

- लगभग 100 ग्राम पंचामृत (दूध, दही, चीनी, शहद, और घी का मिश्रण)

- लगभग 50 ग्राम दही
- लगभग 100 ग्राम दूध

7. शिवजी की पूजा के लिए, नौ कप तैयार करें जिनमें निम्नलिखित सामग्री हो:
- लगभग 50 ग्राम दूध, दही, और शहद का मिश्रण (इसे मधुपाक कहते हैं)

5. एक प्लेट जिसमें प्रसाद के रूप में विभिन्न फल और मिठाइयां हों। 6. आरती थाली में दो दीये, एक घी और रुई बत्ती से भरा और दूसरा कपूर से भरा। अतिरिक्त कपूर को दूसरे दीये में रखें।

4. घंटी

- 13. कुछ सिक्के।
- 14. मुट्ठी भर चावल।
- 15. कुमकुम।
- १६. चंदन।
- 17. करम पत्र पूजा के दौरान उपयोग के लिए पानी से भरा एक छोटा बर्तन।
- 18. प्रतिभागियों के उपयोग के लिए थोड़ा चावल।
- 19. प्रतिभागियों के उपयोग के लिए थोड़ा कुमकुम।
- 20. एक छोटा तौलिया।
- 21. रुद्राभिषेक के दौरान उपयोग के लिए 4 लीटर शुद्ध साफ पानी।
- 22. रुद्राभिषेक के दौरान उपयोग के लिए 2 से 3 लीटर दूध।
- 23. भगवान शिव पर चढ़ाए जाने वाले पानी/दूध को संपूर्ण के लिए अतिरिक्त बड़ा खाली बर्तन।

24. आसन।

\*\*नोट:\*\*

दूध और पानी निकालने के लिए एक बड़ा खाली बर्तन रखें, जो भगवान शिव को चढ़ाया जाएगा।

पूजा के दौरान हाथ साफ करने के लिए एक छोटा तौलिया प्रदान करें।

# 4. Sankalp & Its Importance

Sankalp is very important while conducting Puja. It's a determined inclination to do something. Ahead of undertaking any form of puja the people who are undertaking the puja take a sankalp. When the pundit performs the sankalp, it's important to have handy information in the form of a Sankalp information sheet.

The Sankalp Information Sheet is a document containing essential details required during sankalp while performing a puja, such as the Hindu year, month, tithi, day, date, country, city, participant's name, and gotra which the participants have to chant during the sankalp as per the panditji's instruction.

You can easily get these details from DevbhumiDevasthanams website's punchang section by selecting the date when you will be performing the Puja and the city where you'll conduct the Puja. Alternatively, you can refer to other punchangs available on the internet for the same information.

The participants should keep the following information ready, which the participants should chant during the pooja during Sankalpa as per Pandit ji instructions.

# 5. Muharat & Its Importance

Mahurat plays a very important role. Doing anything during an auspicious mahurat yields positive results, so through digital puja, you can perform rituals according to your convenience without depending on a pandit.

Although the entire month of Sawan is considered special for Rudrabhishek, all Mondays, Sawan Shivratri, and Nag Panchami are particularly significant. It is believed that performing Rudrabhishek on these special days fulfills not just one but 18 types of desires and removes all kinds of sufferings from your life.

#### 6. How to login

Whenever you are performing Puja, just login to your user ID at <u>www.devbhumidevasthamans.com</u> and follow the dashboard accordingly.

### 7. Disclaimer

The validity to access the video for Shivji Rudraabhsiek puja is 10 days from the date of purchase .

For the user, the Puja video can be accessed in three devices only and further the access will have restriction and the Puja will be not played in more than 3 devices.

Dakshina holds significant importance in Hindu rituals, especially during Puja.

If you wish to offer Dakshina, there are three ways to do so.

- You can give Dakshina to the Panditji nearby your locality.
- You can offer Dakshina at a nearby temple.
- You can also give Dakshina to the Pandit at Devbhumi Devasthanams.

## 8. Refund Policy

If you are not satisfied with the conduct of the Puja and services, you can claim your refund at the refund section in Devbhumi Devasthanams website.

You must claim the refund within 72 hours of your Puja expiry video. A nominal bank transaction fee will be deducted, and the remaining amount will be refunded to you.

### 9. Useful Tips

- 1. Watch the Puja video before conducting the main Puja. You can scroll the video to have a overlook if you don't have time to watch the entire video.
- 2. Arrange the Puja layout as per the Puja layout or Puja preparation video.
- 3. During the Puja day, just play and perform the Puja.
- 4. If any work comes up while doing puja, you can pause the video and when your work is completed then you can play the video again.
