

Simple Steps

Conduct Puja with four simple steps:

- 1. Prepare for Puja Samagri as per the provided list
- 2. Arrange Samagri as per Puja Layout
- 3. Overlook the Puja With Flow Video
- 4. Log in ,Play & Perform the Puja

Samagris to be arranged for the Puja ceremony, here's a list of the non-perishable items (things that can be stored for long periods)

Lord Ganesh & Maa Laxmi	Your personal from ur home, or new one
Idol	from the market.
Kalash	1 piece.
Diya	6 pieces small & 1 big
Red cloth	1 meter.
Chandan	10 grams.
Kumkum	a small packet.
Rice	50 grams.
Suparis	5 pieces.
Attar (scent)	1 small bottle.
Janau	3 pieces.
Moli	1 gola.
Coins	a few.
Kapoor	Few tabs
Rui batti /cotton wicks	10 pieces.
Dhoop	a few sticks.
Matchbox	1 box.
Ghee	20 grams.
Bell	1
Towel	1
Aasan	1
Sarso Tel	100 grams
Silver Coin	1 piece
Note book	1 piece
Pen	1 piece
Sabut Dhaniya	1 handfull
Kamal Gatta	5 pieces
Haldi Gath	3 pieces
Majit	4 to 5 pieces


Here's the list of perishable items (things that cannot be stored for long periods) you need to arrange a day before or on puja day.

PHOOL /DHURVA/TULSI/BELPATRA	Around 1 thali (refer photo in photo layout)
Lotus & rose	1 piece
Small Mala	5 pieces.
Coconut	1 piece
Fruits	Few different varieties (refer quantity as per puja layout photo)
Sweets including laddu	Few different varieties (refer quantity as per puja layout photo)

These items are typically used in various pujas and ceremonies to honor deities, and each plays a specific role in the rituals. These items are essential for rituals and offerings, contributing to the overall sanctity and success of the ceremony. PUJA PREPRATION -Puja samagri & puja layout

(Match the numbers in the picture with Samagri)



1.	Lord Ganesh & Maa Laxmi Idol
2.	Kalash: Fill the kalash halfway with water, then add a coin, supari, durva, and mango leaf inside. Cover the Kalash with a lid, bowl or plate and fill the bowl/plate with rice, place a coconut wrapped in red cloth over it and place some flowers.
3.	Take a small plate /bowl and fill it with rice, and place 2 suparis wrapped with moli, and one janau on one supari. This is the preparation for Ganesh Ambika, with the Janue representing Lord Ganesh.
4	Prasad-Fruits,sweets and Meetha Pan
5	Silver Coin
6	Haldi gath ,majit and kamal gatta .sabut dhaniya
7.	Note book & Pen
8.	Bell
9	6 small diyas & 1 big diya in Sarso tel with rui batti
10	Ghee Deepak, Dhoop/Agarbatti, Matchbox (banana can be used as agarbatti stand)
11	Aarti thali- one ghee diya, One kapoor diya and extra kapoor
12	2- Janau
13	Mauli
14	supari
15	Few Coins for Dakshina
16	Chawal /Akshat
17	kumkum
18	Chandan
19	Karma Patra (Vessel filled with water and spoon or Dhruva)
20	Little rice for the use of participants
21	Kumkum for participants
22	Flowers, big bunch of durva and durva mala and other galrlands, bel patra and tulsi and a lotus flower & rose flower
23	Towel
24	Aasan

Sankalp & Its Importance

Sankalp is a crucial element in performing Puja, representing a determined resolve to undertake the ritual. Before beginning any Puja, the participants make a Sankalp, which is a formal declaration of their intent. To facilitate this process, it is important to arrange information as mentioned in sankalp information sheet provided in this user manual.

The Sankalp Information Sheet includes key details needed during the Sankalp, such as the Hindu year, month, tithi, day, date, country, city, participant's name, and gotra etc. These details must be recited as instructed by the pundit during the Puja.

You can obtain this information from the Punchang section on our website by selecting the date and city where the Puja will be conducted. Alternatively, other online punchangs can also provide the necessary details



During Sankalp Required information



The participants should keep the following information ready, which the participants should chant during the pooja during Sankalpa as per Pandit ji instructions.

How to login

Whenever you are performing Puja, just login to your user ID at www.devbhumipuja.com and follow the dashboard accordingly.

Disclaimer

The validity to access the is 10 days from date of purchase

For the user, the Puja video can be accessed in three devices only and further the access will have restriction and the Puja will be not played in more than 3 devices.

Dakshina holds significant importance in Hindu rituals, especially during Puja.

If you wish to offer Dakshina, there are three ways to do so.

- You can give Dakshina to the Panditji nearby your locality.
- You can offer Dakshina at a nearby temple.
- You can also give Dakshina to the Pandit at Devbhumipuja.com

Useful Tips

- 1. Watch the Puja video before conducting the main Puja. You can scroll the video to have a overlook if you don't have time to watch the entire video.
- 2. Arrange the Puja layout as per the Puja layout or Puja preparation video.
- 3. During the Puja day, just play and perform the Puja.
- 4. If any work comes up while doing puja, you can pause the video and when your work is completed then you can play the video again.
