A. Puja Samagri kit contains

Diya, diya small, Red cloth , chandan, kumkum ,rice (akshat), supari (beetal nut), janau, moli (kalava), kapoor (champur), rui batti (cottom wicks), dhoop (agarbatti), match box, ghee , peela sarso , long, elichai, panch mewa (dry fruits), attar (scent), ganga jal , rose water , soil (mitti), honey ,bhang,sugar ,mahamritunjay yantra,shringi, kumar ki mitti, Abir ,Gulal , Bhasma,Sindoor , hand towel for self use , Hand towel for puja use,kusha ,pavitri (Kusha ring)

B. Other items to be arranged

C. Here's the list of perishable items
(things that cannot be stored for long periods)
you need to arrange a day before or on puja day.

Mahamrityunjay yantra

Spiritual Significance

Devotees and practitioners turn to the Shri Mahamritunjay Yantra for protection from illnesses, accidents, and untimely death. It is believed that meditating upon or worshipping this Yantra can invoke Lord Shiva's blessings, granting relief from physical ailments, spiritual rejuvenation, and peace of mind.

How to use Mahamrityunjaya Yantra

1. Place the Yantra facing the North West direction of your house or in puja altar.
2. Offer daily incense to the yantra.
3. Offer sandal paste in the center of the Yantra.
4. Offer Prasada (sweet offerings) to the yantra.
5. Chant the Mantra of the Yantra, minimum 11 times.

Subh Muhurat for performing Rudrabhishek

Rudrabhishek can be performed on many auspicious days, including:

Mahashivratri a revered festival that honors Lord Shiva in his Rudra aspect. Mondays in Shravan, Bhadrapad, Ashwin, or Kartik: Some say these are the most appropriate days for Rudrabhishek. Pradosha, Chaturdaashi, Purnima, or Amavasya: Some say these are the best days to perform Rudrabhishek.

Puja samagri & puja layout (Match the numbers)

- Those who keep a Shivling at home can place their Shiv ling. And those whose homes do not have a Shivling have the option to craft one from clay.
- Kalash: Fill the kalash halfway with water, then add a coin, supari, durva, and mango leaf inside. Outside the Kalash, cover it with a saari or plate, fill it with rice, place a coconut wrapped in red cloth, and adorn it with flowers.
- Take a small plate or saari, fill it with rice, and place 2 suparis wrapped with moli, and one janau on one supari. This is the preparation for Ganesh Ambika, with the Janue representing Lord Ganesh.
- Bell
- One plate with various fruits and sweets for offering as Prasad.
- Aarti thali with two diyas, one filled with ghee and cotton bati, while the other with camphor (Kapoore).keep extra kapoor in another diya
- For Shivji puja, arrange nine cups each containing:
 - Mixture of milk, curd, and honey totaling 50 grams.
(It is called madhupak)
 - Around 100 grams of milk.
 - Around 50 grams of curd.
 - Around 20 grams of sugar.

- v. Around 20 grams of ghee.
- vi. Around 20 grams of honey.
- vii. Around 20g Chandan and a little Attar(scent) mixed in water
- viii. Panchamrit: a mixture of milk, curd, sugar, honey, and ghee totalling 100 grams.
- ix. Around 50 grams of milk mixed with a little bhang and a little sugar. Use a small vessel (kalash) made of non-copper material or Shringi (Shringi is used during rudraabhishek, if you do not have shringi you can use a vessel (Kalash) made of non-copper
8. Prepare a ghee lamp using a small diya, cup, or saari, filled with ghee and a few agarbatti to light, a banana as a stand to keep agarbatti and a matchbox
9. Empty vessel to store water and milk poured on lord shiva
10. A plate consisting of Durva, approximately half a kilogram of flowers, a minimum of 10 Bel Patra, 2 to 3 garlands, and a bunch of tulsi
11. few pieces of supari,itar and 2 janau
12. Moli
13. few coins
14. Handful of rice
15. Kumkum
16. Chandan
17. Karam Patra - a small vessel filled with water for use during the puja.
18. little rice for participants use
19. little kumkum for participants use
20. Small towel
21. Pure clean water 4 liters to be used during rudra abhishek
22. Two to three litres of milk to be used during rudra abhishek
23. extra bigger size empty vessel to dispose of water/milk which would be poured on lord shiva
24. Aasan

Note: Keep a large empty vessel for draining milk and water, which will be offered to Lord Shiva. Provide a small towel for hand cleaning during the puja.

Disclaimer

- * The validity to access Panditji is 30 days from the activation of Copoun code.
- * For the user, the Puja can be accessed in three devices only and further the access will have restriction and the Puja will be not available in more than 3 devices.

Braj Raj (Vrindavan ki Mitti)

There are many beliefs about the Raj of Vrindavan i.e. the soil of Braj: Vrindavan's glory is due to the fact that Lord Krishna and Radha Rani used to play pranks here. Radha Rani used to wander barefoot in the soil here. Lord Shri Krishna took the dust of Radha Rani's feet and applied it on his forehead.

- * Many pundits believe that bringing Raj from Vrindavan is considered auspicious. It is believed that by keeping this Raj in the house, every disease and defect goes away and the fear of untimely death ends.
- * The Raj of Vrindavan should be kept at the place in the house where Thakur ji resides.
- * After taking bath daily, this raja should be put on the forehead and a little in the mouth.

Gangajal

Gangajal is used in many different ways. Devotees sprinkle it in their homes after daily puja to purify the environment, add a little to their bath water to cleanse themselves, offer it to the deities in the home temple, and much more.

Sprinkling in homes: Devotees sprinkle Gangajal in their homes after daily puja to purify the environment

Adding to bath water: Devotees add a little Gangajal to their bath water to cleanse themselves

Offering to deities: Gangajal is offered to the deities in the home temple

Death rituals: Gangajal is placed in the mouth of the deceased to make sure that the soul reaches heaven

Rose water

Rose water is a key part of many Hindu puja rituals

Purification

Rose water is used to cleanse and sanctify the items used in puja, such as the deity's idol, puja utensils, and the place of worship.

Devotion

Rose water is offered to the deities as a way to express love and reverence, and to seek their blessings.

Spiritual connection

The fragrance of rose water is believed to elevate one's senses and create a more profound spiritual connection during worship.

Cooling effect

Rose water is known for its cooling properties, and is sometimes sprayed or sprinkled during puja to create a refreshing effect.

Heart chakra

Rose water is associated with the heart chakra, which is believed to be the center of love and devotion.

Symbolism

Roses represent beauty, purity, and love.

Healing energy

Rose water is considered to carry healing energy when it touches the idol of the deity.
